TITLE: REFERRAL TO THE LAND USE AND SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE – DISCUSS AMENDING THE MIAMI BEACH RESILIENCY CODE TO WAIVE OR REDUCE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD APPLICATION FEES FOR ADDITIONS, RENOVATIONS, AND REHABILITATION OF SINGLE-FAMILY HOMES WITHIN LOCAL HISTORIC DISTRICTS OR INDIVIDUALLY DESIGNATED HISTORIC SITES.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Please place the above item on the October 30, 2024 City Commission meeting agenda as a referral to the Land Use and Sustainability Committee (“LUSC”).

I would like the LUSC to discuss amending the Miami Beach Resiliency Code to waive or reduce Historic Preservation Board (“HPB”) application fees for single-family homes within local historic districts or individually designated historic sites. Eligibility for a waiver or reduction should be limited to additions, renovations, and rehabilitation of single-family homes that require HPB review.

If the LUSC recommends in favor, I intend to sponsor a subsequent referral of an LDR amendment to the Planning Board.
