BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Between the last meeting on July 24, 2024, and the first regularly scheduled meeting on September 11, 2024, the City Commission will not be in session. During this period there may be bids or contracts in excess of the \$100,000 for goods and services or \$300,000 for construction, which may need to be issued, rejected, awarded, or terminated.

Typically, during the City Commission's recess period, the City Manager has been authorized by the City Commission to sign all contracts, agreements, and grant applications; renew any existing contracts and terminate existing contracts, as needed, from the last Commission meeting on July 24, 2024, until the first regularly scheduled Commission meeting on September 11, 2024, subject to ratification by the City Commission at its first regularly scheduled meeting on September 11, 2024.

ANALYSIS

The requested authorization is necessary to ensure that essential services and projects continue for the period during which the City Commission is in recess.
