Pride Park was proposed as an area that would be for the residents above all events and a shared community space for all to enjoy. At this juncture, residents desire to have a greater amount of days to enjoy this beautiful area without event activation.

To further define a more resident-accessible policy for Pride Park, I would like for the PSNQLC to consider which amendments may be appropriate to reduce the amount of special event activation days while continuing to accommodate signature events such as Design Miami and the Boat Show.

I urge my colleagues to join me in support of our residents as we come to a reasonable limit on days that Pride Park can be used as an event space.
