SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND NEIGHBORHOOD QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE
 TO DISCUSS OPTIONS IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CONCERNS
 REGARDING THE CASE DISPOSITION DATA PROVIDED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY
 CLERK OF THE COURTS.

ANALYSIS

Please place on the December 14, 2022 agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss the options available to the City in order to most effectively address the Police Department's concerns regarding the case disposition data and information provided to the Police Department by the Miami-Dade County Clerk of the Courts ("Clerk of Courts"). Specifically, in adopting Resolution No. 2021-31587, the Mayor and City Commission directed the City Administration to request, from the Clerk of Courts, case disposition data and information for all felony, misdemeanor, and traffic citation cases initiated by the Miami Beach Police Department. As such, the City, by and through the Police Department, paid Miami-Dade County for this service; however, the data and information received is not all-inclusive, and also contains errors and omissions.

As part of this referral, I would request that the Police Department be prepared to provide an update as to all outstanding concerns relating to the data and information received, in conjunction with any steps taken to rectify these concerns and the Police Department's recommendation(s) as to how best work with the Clerk of Courts in order to resolve any remaining issues.
