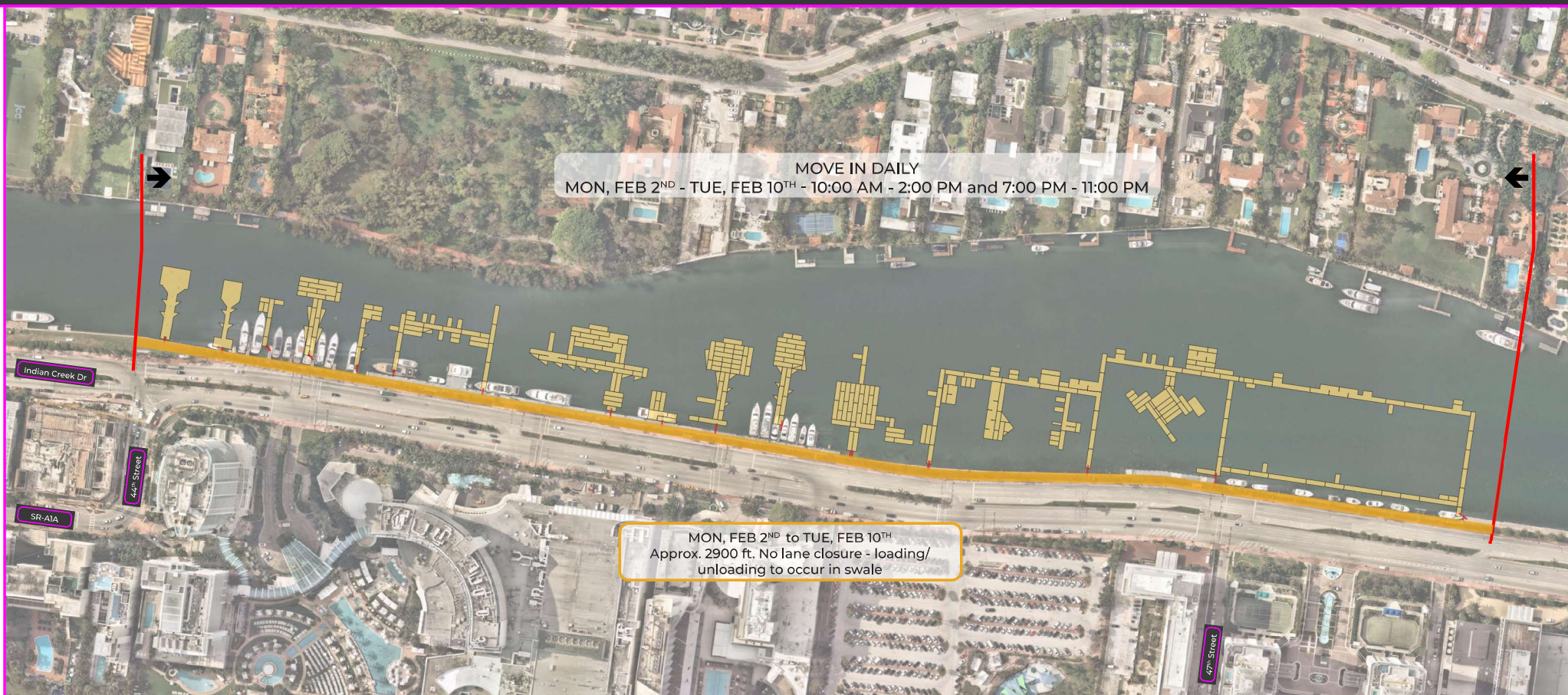

EXHIBITOR MOVE-IN OPERATIONS

Monday, February 2nd to Tuesday, February 10th - 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm to 11:00 pm



GENERAL NOTES:

- Move-in will occur during a total of nine (9) days during the off-peak hours from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM to 11:00 PM.
- Boats will be moved in utilizing the 63rd Street bascule bridge. Proper coordination with the City and the Coast Guard is occurring to reduce potential impact to traffic.
- Bridge openings will be scheduled at 10-min intervals on the hour, only as needed.
- Load-in activity on Collins Avenue and 41st Street may occur between 9:30am-3:00pm and 7pm-11pm on weekdays and 9:00am-11:00pm on weekends, or as otherwise authorized by the City through the special event permit.
- Float Mobilization for docks will occur prior to show.

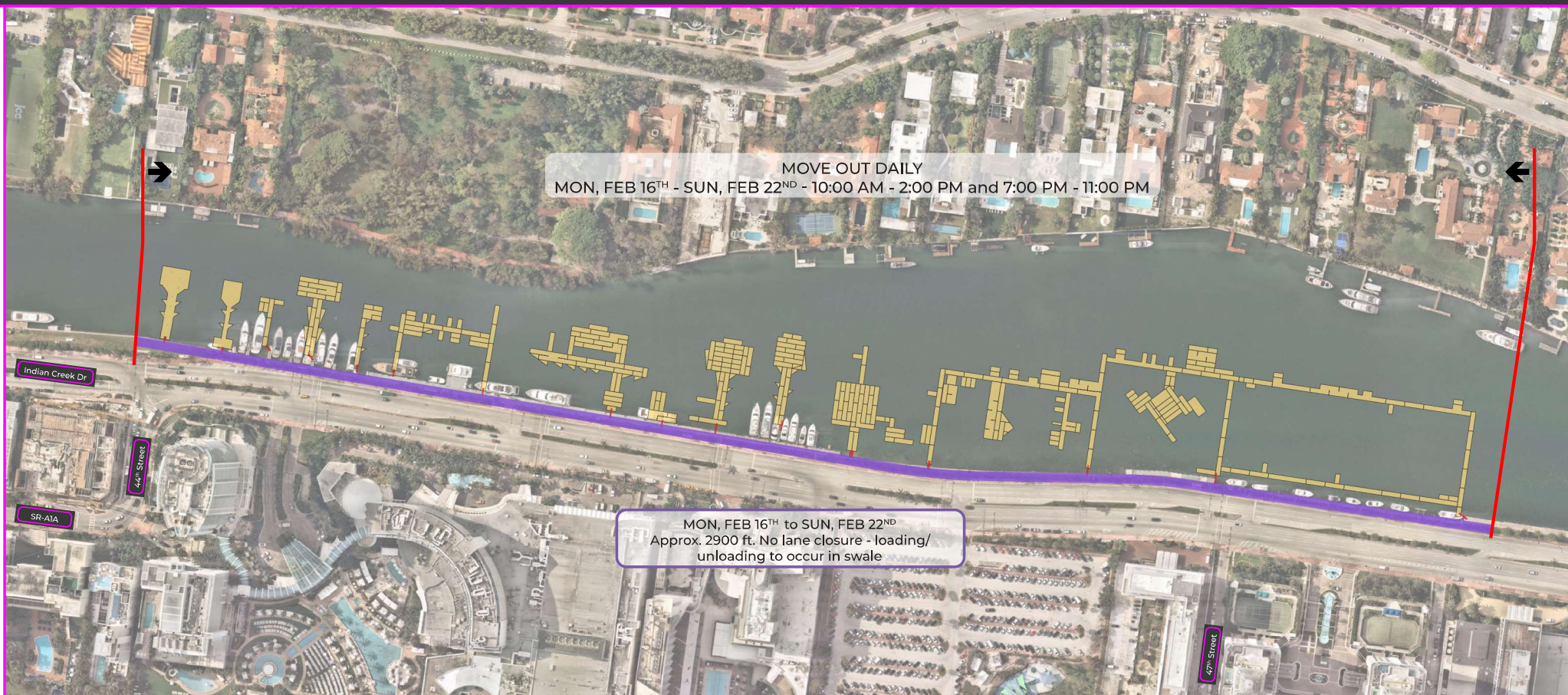

- Boats will be moved out utilizing the 63rd Street bascule bridge. Proper coordination with the City and the Coast Guard is occurring to reduce potential impact to traffic.
- Bridge openings will be scheduled at 10-min intervals on the hour, only as needed.
- Load-out activity on Collins Avenue and 41st Street may occur between 9:30am-3:00pm and 7pm-11pm on weekdays and 9:00am-11:00pm on weekends, or as otherwise authorized by the City through the special event permit.
- Float De-mobilization for docks will occur following the show.
