

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-33136

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION (1) TO DEVELOP A "LEAVE NO TRACE" POLICY FOR MONUMENT ISLAND, CITY PARKS AND OTHER CITY-OWNED LANDS AND FACILITIES AND (2) TO PRESENT THE POLICY TO THE CITY COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL AT ITS JULY 24, 2024 MEETING.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach recognizes the importance of preserving the natural beauty and environmental integrity of Monument Island, City parks and other City-owned lands and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to promoting responsible and sustainable use of these natural resources; and


WHEREAS, implementing a "Leave No Trace" policy for these areas is essential to achieve the goals of preservation and responsible stewardship; and

WHEREAS, the "Leave No Trace" policy shall include guidelines, regulations, and educational programs to promote responsible use, conservation, and minimal impact on the environment for visitors and users of these areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the City Administration (1) to develop a "Leave No Trace" policy for Monument Island, City parks and other City-owned lands and facilities and (2) to present the policy to the City Commission for approval at its July 24, 2024 meeting.
