Please place on the February 26, 2025 agenda a referral to the Art in Public Places Committee requesting them to consider featuring artworks by lesser-known artists.

Many talented artists in Miami Beach struggle for recognition. Some of these young artists have entered major art contests in which there is no chance to win since the established, known, well-connected artists dominate those type of contests. A city-led contest could provide them exposure and financial support, fostering a more inclusive artistic environment.

One potential initiative could involve an art contest with multiple winners, with winning artworks displayed in underutilized public spaces like the tennis center, Scott Rakow Youth Center, and the golf course, enriching these locations.
