Additional Funding for Cleanup and Maintenance of the City's Waterways	Environmental Resources Management	Suarez	\$ 289,000	\$ 289,000	-	-					<p>This request aims to increase funding in the Sanitation Fund to support an enhanced level of service for routine and emergency cleanup across approximately 60 miles of waterways surrounding the City, which totals about 3,000 acres of canals, basins, and water passages, as discussed and recommended by the Finance and Economic Resiliency Committee (FERC) at its May 24, 2024 meeting and adopted by the City Commission on XXXXXX, 2024, through Resolution No. 2024.XXXXX.</p> <p>The proposed service expansion includes the removal of organic materials and increasing cleanup frequency to five days per week. This enhanced service level would raise the annual costs from around \$231,000 to \$520,000 requiring an additional \$289,000 annually to support the proposed service enhancement.</p> <p>Pending discussion on determination of funding source, if recommended. Currently, the item is being recommended to be funded from Sanitation's budget</p>
