RECOMMENDATION

Please place on the October 30, 2024, City Commission agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss the implementation of traffic calming measures on Meridian Avenue between 42nd and 47th Street.

Residents in the area have expressed significant concerns regarding traffic volume and speeding, which have created an unsafe environment for pedestrians and drivers alike. As part of this referral, I ask that the Administration provide guidance on appropriate areas along Meridian Avenue for the implementation of traffic calming measures. Residents have suggested solutions such as speed tables to help address these issues. Addressing these concerns is vital for ensuring the safety and quality of life in our neighborhoods.
