RECOMMENDATION

The Administration recommends that the Land Use and Sustainability Committee discuss the item and provide a recommendation to the Mayor and City Commission (City Commission).

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

On July 24, 2024, the Mayor and City Commission approved items R5 Y and R5 Z, which are amendments to the Land Development Regulations of the City Code (LDRs) and the Comprehensive Plan, pertaining to residential use incentives in certain multi-family districts. The City Commission also referred both ordinance amendments to the Land Use and Sustainability Committee (LUSC) for additional discussion prior to Second Reading, which is scheduled for October 30, 2024.

ANALYSIS

Attached are the ordinances approved at First Reading on July 24, 2024, as well as the corresponding commission memos, which summarize the proposal. The proposed amendments to the LDRs and comprehensive plan contains incentives that are intended to reduce the number of transient uses and facilitate permanent residents to move into the City.
