A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO PRIORITIZE FUNDING IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$101,383.50 DURING THE FY 2026 BUDGET PROCESS FOR THE PURCHASE, INSTALLATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF SEASONAL ANNUAL PLANTS ALONG LINCOLN ROAD AHEAD OF THE 2025 HOLIDAY SEASON.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach is a vibrant and welcoming community that attracts visitors year-round to enjoy its cultural and recreational offerings; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln Road is a prominent pedestrian thoroughfare and a key destination for residents and visitors, especially during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, beautifying public spaces and creating an inviting atmosphere can significantly enhance the overall experience for both residents and visitors, contributing to the community's economic vitality and festive spirit; and

WHEREAS, the installation of seasonally appropriate annual flowering plants in planters along Lincoln Road in November 2025 would promote the holiday season, and beautify the area in preparation for Thanksgiving, Art Basel, and other high impact dates, enhancing the aesthetic appeal and festive ambiance of this popular location and increasing foot traffic; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration collaborated with the Lincoln Road Business Improvement District, and existing City Contractor, SFM Services, Inc., to explore the feasibility of the Lincoln Road Mall Annuals Planting Pilot Project; and

WHEREAS, according to the Scope of the Project, attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution, the Project seeks to install 6,500 1-gallon annuals along designated planter beds at Lincoln Road Mall as part of a one-time pilot project that will last the duration of one (1) life-cycle of the annuals, at an estimated cost of \$101,383.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA that the Mayor and the City hereby direct the City Administration to prioritize funding in the total amount of \$101,383.50 during the FY 2026 budget process for the purchase, installation, and maintenance of seasonal annual plants along Lincoln Road ahead of the 2025 holiday season.
