**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION (1) TO DEVELOP A “LEAVE NO TRACE” POLICY FOR MONUMENT ISLAND, CITY PARKS AND OTHER CITY-OWNED LANDS AND FACILITIES AND (2) TO PRESENT THE POLICY TO THE CITY COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL AT ITS JULY 24, 2024 MEETING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Miami Beach recognizes the importance of preserving the natural beauty and environmental integrity of Monument Island, City parks and other City-owned lands and facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is committed to promoting responsible and sustainable use of these natural resources; and

**WHEREAS**, implementing a “Leave No Trace” policy for these areas is essential to achieve the goals of preservation and responsible stewardship; and

**WHEREAS**, the “Leave No Trace” policy shall include guidelines, regulations, and educational programs to promote responsible use, conservation, and minimal impact on the environment for visitors and users of these areas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the City Administration (1) to develop a “Leave No Trace” policy for Monument Island, City parks and other City-owned lands and facilities and (2) to present the policy to the City Commission for approval at its July 24, 2024 meeting.
