RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

ANALYSIS

The attached Resolution formally adopts the Certificate of Results of the City of Miami Beach November 5, 2024 Special Election (Special Election) and declares the election results for the seven ballot questions that were the subject of the Special Election. Passage of this Resolution accepts the election results and effectively concludes the City Commission's action relative to the Special Election.

The Unofficial Results of the Special Election are attached. Upon receipt of the Official Certificate of Election on November 18, 2024, the results will be attached to the Resolution and made part of the public record.

Note that the public measure - Miami Beach Referendum 8, Approve 1% Tax on Food and Beverage Sales for Homeless Assistance / Domestic Violence Centers - was ordered removed from the ballot. Any vote cast for this public measure did not count for approval or rejection of the public measure.
