**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING (AND, AS TO CERTAIN AGREEMENTS, RETROACTIVELY APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING) THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR, AND ACCEPT FUNDING, EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS OR AGREEMENTS, AND APPROPRIATE FUNDING RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOLLOWING GRANTS, PROGRAMS, AND AGREEMENTS: 1) FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, PUBLIC TRANSIT SERVICE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$1.4 MILLION; 2) FLORIDA COMMERCE/FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY, COMMUNITY PLANNING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$50,000; 3) U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FY24 COMMUNITY POLICING DEVELOPMENT MICROGRANTS PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$488,000; AND 4) U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, FLORIDA DISTRICT 24 CONGRESSIONAL FY25 COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING REQUEST, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$13.1 MILLION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration applies for grants and external funding from outside organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration requests approval to apply for two grants in the approximate amount of \$1.4 Million from Florida Department of Transportation, Public Transit Service Development Program, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration requests approval to apply for a grant in the approximate amount of \$50,000 from Florida Commerce/Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, Community Planning Technical Assistance Grants, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration requests approval to apply for three grants in the approximate amount of \$488,000 from U.S. Department of Justice, FY 2024 Community Policing Development Microgrants Program, through The United Way of Miami-Dade County, Emergency Food and Shelter Program, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration requests approval to apply for an appropriation in the approximate amount of \$13.1 Million from U.S. House of Representatives, Florida District 24 Congressional FY25 Community Project Funding Request, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby approve and authorize (and, as to certain agreements, retroactively approve and authorize) the City Manager, or her designee, to apply for, and accept funding, execute any and all documents or agreements, and appropriate funding received by the City of Miami Beach

in connection with following grants, programs, and agreements: 1) Florida Department of Transportation, Public Transit Service Development Program, in the approximate amount of \$1.4 Million; 2) Florida Commerce/Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, Community Planning Technical Assistance Grants, in the approximate amount of \$50,000; 3) U.S. Department of Justice, FY24 Community Policing Development Microgrants Program, in the approximate amount of \$488,000; and 4) U.S. House of Representatives, Florida District 24 Congressional FY25 Community Project Funding Request, in the approximate amount of \$13.1 Million.
