TITLE: A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO IMPLEMENT APPROPRIATE MEASURES, SUCH AS ENHANCED SIGNAGE AND ROAD MARKINGS, PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS, ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL TO DIRECT TRAFFIC, INCREASED TICKETING AND ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS, AND/OR SIGNAL TIMING ADJUSTMENTS, IN AN EFFORT TO MITIGATE TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND DANGEROUS SITUATIONS IN THE ROADWAYS BY PREVENTING AND ENFORCING "BLOCK THE BOX" VIOLATIONS AT MAJOR INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THOSE ALONG 71ST STREET AND 41ST STREET.
