TITLE: REFERRAL TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND NEIGHBORHOOD QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS DECREASING INFRASTRUCTURAL STREET CLUTTER ON SIDEWALKS THAT INHIBITS THE INTENDED USE OF THE PEDESTRIAN RIGHT-OF-WAY.

RECOMMENDATION

Please place on the November 20, 2024 agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee (PSNQLC) to discuss decreasing infrastructural street clutter on sidewalks that inhibits the intended use of the pedestrian right-of-way. Examples include excessive or poorly spaced light/service poles, newspaper boxes, electrical boxes, and directional signage that is superfluous. The chaotic placement of this clutter clashes with the walkability of the City of Miami Beach, interrupts the right-of-way, and significantly detracts from the scenic design of our city.
