As a professional with a background in architecture and design, and someone who was directly involved in the development of the neighboring Faena District projects, I am writing to express my enthusiastic support for the proposed redevelopment of 3611–3621 Collins Avenue by 13th Floor Investments, Midtown Equities, and the Cipriani family. I have worked with the architect Brandon Haw extensively and I really value his professionalism and design approach.

Casa Cipriani Miami represents a highly considered and architecturally significant contribution to the evolution of Collins Avenue. The design demonstrates a deep understanding of—and respect for—the historic urban fabric of Miami Beach.
