The updated priorities are updated in the package and provided to the state team.

### **ANALYSIS**

The attached package outlines Miami Beach's legislative program for the 2025 legislative session. Although the priorities indicate where the City's advocacy efforts should be directed in Tallahassee, the list is not finite, as the Mayor and City Commission may need to respond to any future emerging issues or developments that will require action.

Furthermore, it is important for the City of Miami Beach to collaborate with the Miami-Dade Delegation, especially the elected officials representing Miami Beach. The administration will coordinate with our lobbyists to arrange necessary briefings and trips to Tallahassee to advocate for legislative changes, secure project funding, and engage with state agencies on key matters
