RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE FINANCE AND ECONOMIC RESILIENCE COMMITTEE AT ITS MAY 7, 2025 MEETING FOR ITEM NB 5 FOR FUNDING FOR A SHADE STRUCTURE AT MIAMI BEACH SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$120,000 TO BE CONSIDERED DURING THE FY 2026 BUDGET PROCESS.

WHEREAS, at the February 3, 2025 Commission Meeting, Item C4 AP was referred to the Finance and Economic Resilience Committee to discuss a possible contribution to Miami Beach Senior High School (MBSH) to help fund renovations of the field; and

WHEREAS, the MBSH Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) raised \$24,000 on Give Miami Day to assist in the renovations of the field, while additional funding is required to complete the desired upgrades; and

WHEREAS, at the May 7, 2025, Finance and Economic Resilience Committee meeting, the Committee favorably recommended the inclusion of funding for a shade structure at MBSH in an amount not to exceed \$120,000 as part of the FY 2026 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has evaluated the request in light of critical financial considerations, including the City's increasing unfunded capital improvement program, projected General Fund shortfalls, and new fiscal impacts such as the 2% collection fee imposed by the Miami-Dade Tax Collector and the passage of Amendment 5 in November 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the Finance and Economic Resilience Committee for funding for a shade structure at Miami Beach Senior High School in an amount not to exceed \$120,000, to be considered during the FY 2026 budget process.
