TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, CHAPTER 66, ENTITLED "MARINE STRUCTURES, FACILITIES AND VESSELS," ARTICLE III, ENTITLED "PIERS, DOCKS AND BOAT RAMPS," BY AMENDING SECTION 66-107, ENTITLED "USE OF THE BARRY KUTUN BOAT RAMP AND ASSOCIATED PIERS/DOCKS AT MAURICE GIBB PARK," TO ESTABLISH A DOCKAGE AGREEMENT PROGRAM AT THE BARRY KUTUN BOAT RAMP AT MAURICE GIBB PARK; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

ANALYSIS

Miami Beach City Code Sec. 66-107 currently does not allow dockage of any vessel at the Barry Kutun Boat Ramp at Maurice Gibb Park.

The proposed ordinance would authorize a dockage agreement program for the Barry Kutun Boat Ramp at Maurice Gibb Park.

If the proposed ordinance is enacted, the Mayor and City Commission shall, by resolution, following enactment of this Ordinance, enumerate terms and conditions for the issuance of dockage agreements to Miami Beach residents for short-term dockage at the Barry Kutun Boat Ramp at Maurice Gibb Park.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The proposed ordinance would have a positive fiscal impact by generating dockage agreement fees, but would create enforcement expenses associated with it.
