BACKGROUND/HISTORY

On November 20, 2024, at the request of Commissioner Tanya K. Bhatt, the Mayor and City Commission (City Commission) referred the item (C4 W) to the LUSC.

ANALYSIS

As noted in the attached referral memo, the item sponsor seeks to initiate a discussion between the City of Miami Beach and Miami-Dade County Public Schools (MDCPS) to promote historic preservation and the adaptive re-use of historic buildings on school properties within the City. As part of this referral, the sponsor has also extended an invitation to representatives from MDCPS to attend the LUSC meeting and engage in preliminary discussions.

The Administration has reached out to representatives from MDCPS, to confirm their availability to participate in the January 16, 2025, LUSC meeting, as well as future meetings.
