The survey will provide valuable insights into the demographics and motivations of those who travel to and from Miami Beach, which may inform future traffic management and housing policies.

The survey could include the following questions:

1. Where do you reside?
2. Where are you going?
3. Do you work in Miami Beach?
4. Would you like to live in Miami Beach?
5. What has stopped you from living in Miami Beach?

The responses to these questions may provide critical data that could guide decisions on the creation of affordable and workforce housing. This data could help determine if increasing the availability of such housing options could potentially alleviate traffic by encouraging more residents to live and work within Miami Beach, reducing the need for daily commutes.
