TITLE: REFERRAL TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND NEIGHBORHOOD QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS EXTENDING INSTALLATION OF WHITE DIVIDING PAVERS TO THE REMAINING AREAS OF THE BEACH WALK.

RECOMMENDATION

Please place on the February 26, 2025, City Commission agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss the extension of white dividing pavers along the beach walk in areas where they are not currently present. This initiative will extend the existing white dividing pavers, which currently run from 25th to 64th streets, to additional segments of the beach walk. In addition, the Committee will consider replacing the current temporary markers along this segment with more durable, permanent demarcations. This initiative will distinguish between northbound and southbound traffic on the beach walk, promoting a safer use of the shared space.

As part of this referral, I would request that the Administration come prepared at Committee with feedback and recommendations regarding the extension of the existing markers on the beach walk, including project estimates.
