TITLE: DISCUSS CONSIDERING BEAUTIFICATION OF THE ALLEYWAYS BEHIND ROASTERS 'N TOASTERS AND CAFÉ AVANTI ON THE 41ST STREET CORRIDOR

RECOMMENDATION

The Administration recommends prioritizing the milling and resurfacing of the alleys behind Roasters 'N Toasters and Café Avanti within the annual appropriation.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

At its February 26, 2025 meeting, the Mayor and City Commission (City Commission) at the request of Commissioner Kristen Rosen Gonzalez, approved a referral item C4Z (Attachment A) to the Neighborhoods and Quality of Life Committee (PSNQLC), to discuss the beautification of the 41st Street alleyways, behind Roasters 'N Toasters (533 Arthur Godfrey Road) and Café Avanti (732 West 41st Street).

Sponsoring Commissioner Rosen Gonzalez believes that the alleyways behind these establishments could benefit from an improved aesthetic appeal and enhancement of the overall neighborhood environment. Commissioner Rosen Gonzalez would like for Committee members to consider options for funding, design, and implementation of a pavement project, in which local stakeholders and property owners could collaborate in.

ANALYSIS

Public Works conducted a search of the parcels and confirmed that both alleyways fall within the City's jurisdiction and are maintained by the Public Works Sanitation Division once a week. The alleyways provide access for both pedestrian and vehicular traffic (from deliveries, trash collection, to regular service of utility poles, manholes, grates, and other public utilities serviced from the alley). The alleyways also connect to a parking lot. The parking lot across from Roasters 'N Toasters belongs to the City, and the parking lot across from Café Avanti belongs to CVS Pharmacy.

In its present condition, both alleyways could be improved with milling and resurfacing of the asphalt pavement. The estimated cost per alley is between \$30 - \$40K or about \$80K for both.

With regards to beautification, since the parking lot across from Roasters 'N Toasters belongs to the City, Public Works Greenspace Management could install sod in the medians. However, the private parking lot by Café Avanti would need to be enhanced by the property owner.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The estimated cost to for milling and resurfacing of both alleys is \$80K, funded within the department's annual appropriation.

CONCLUSION

The Administration recommends prioritizing the milling and resurfacing of the alleys behind Roasters 'N Toasters and Café Avanti within the annual appropriation.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Please place on the February 26, 2025 agenda a dual referral to the Finance and Economic Resiliency Committee and the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss the consideration of a project to beautify the alleyways behind two popular establishments on the 41st Street corridor: Roasters & Toasters and Café Avanti. These businesses are popular places of business along the 41st Street corridor and have two main points of entry, one of which includes the alleyway at the rear of the buildings.

The alleyways behind these establishments currently lack the aesthetic appeal that matches the vibrancy of the businesses and could benefit from improvements to enhance the overall neighborhood environment. A decorative pavement project could be considered for these alleys to improve the aesthetic experience for patrons and passersby, while also contributing to the overall beautification of the 41st Street area.

I am requesting the Committees to consider options for funding, design, and implementation of this project, including potential collaboration with local stakeholders, and property owners in the area.
