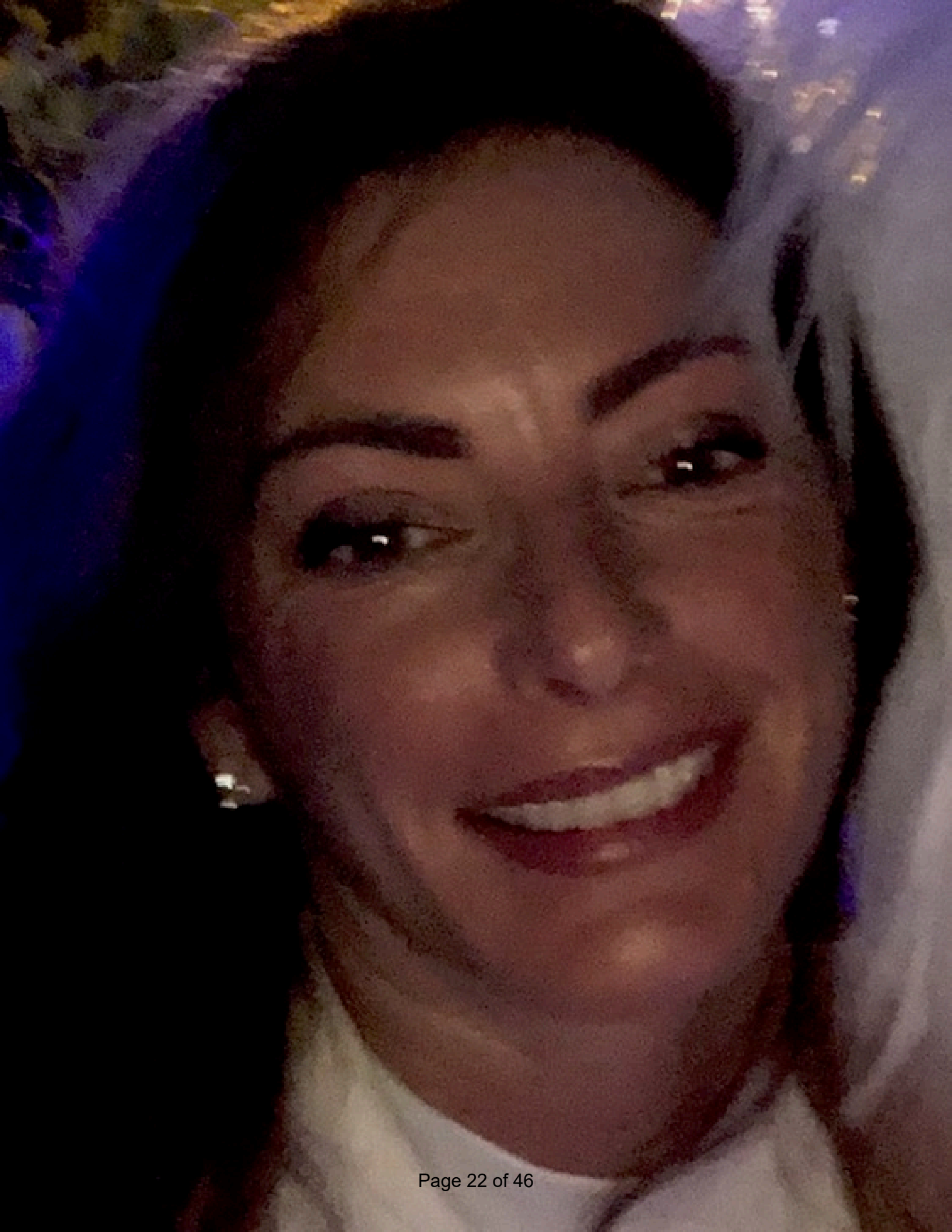

Direlia Lazo (b. 1984, Havana) is an art curator based in Miami, currently leading as the Artistic Director at ZóONAMACO Art Fair in Mexico City. Before her pivotal role, she significantly contributed as a curator for ZóONAMACO Ejes, and also served on the curatorial committee for El Patio I ABC Art Baja California 2023.

Her academic background includes a degree in Art History from Universidad de La Habana and participation in the de Appel Curatorial Programme, Amsterdam (2009-2010). Her career is marked by roles such as Director of Exhibitions at Faena Art in Miami and Buenos Aires, curator at La Tallera, Cuernavaca in Mexico, curatorial researcher for the IX Havana Biennial, and coordinator of the pedagogical project Cátedra Arte de Conducta, founded by artist Tania Bruguera in Havana.

She has also collaborated on significant projects with acclaimed artists such as Wilfredo Prieto, Helen Mirra, Pierre Huyghe, Roman Signer, Wu Tsang, Isabel Lewis, and Kiani del Valle, among others. She co-curated the first comprehensive survey of Roman Ondák's work in China, presented at Times Museum Guangzhou, showcasing her global curatorial reach and commitment to fostering artistic dialogue.
