BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The City of Miami Beach applies for various grants and funding allocations from external agencies and organizations. Information regarding the projects and funding sources is included in the Analysis section of this Agenda Item.

ANALYSIS

1. U.S. House of Representatives, FY26 Community Project Appropriations Funding Request, in the approximate amount of \$5 Million for Fire Station #1.

Congresswoman Frederica Wilson is accepting FY26 Community Project Funding applications that will be submitted to the U.S. House of Representatives Appropriations Committee.

The City administration is applying for a federal appropriation in the approximate amount of \$5 Million for Fire Station #1. The funding will be spent on the construction of a new resilient facility to withstand a Category 5 hurricane, and to house critical equipment and emergency systems. No matching funds are required.
