BOARD AND COMMITTEES:

1. AD HOC CITY LIGHTING PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (2):

- One North Beach resident.
- One Technical Member – Electrical engineer, preferably with expertise in urban lighting.

2. AD HOC CITY SANITATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (3):

- Two North Beach residents.
- One member from the City as a whole.

3. AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (5):

Five members shall be appointed at large by a majority vote of the Mayor and City Commission. These appointments must come from the following categories, with no more than one member representing each category.

- Representing those areas of labor actively engaged in home building in connection with affordable housing. (Category # 3)
- Actively engaged as a for-profit provider of affordable housing. (Category # 5)
- Actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing. (Category # 6)
- Actively serves on the local planning agency pursuant to Florida Statutes §163.3174 (Planning Board member) (Category # 8)
- Resides within the jurisdiction of the local governing body making the appointments. (Category # 9)
- Represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan. (Category # 11)

Clerk's Note: If the City, due to the presence of a conflict of interest by prospective appointees or other reasonable factors, is unable to appoint a citizen actively engaged in these activities in connection with affordable housing, a citizen engaged in the activity without regard to affordable housing may be appointed.

4. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

VACANCY (1):

- One member who shall possess a high degree of competence in the evaluation of art history and architectural history, art, architecture, sculpture, painting, artistic structure design, and other appropriate art media for display or integration in public places.

5. BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- One Certified Public Accountant.

6. GENERAL OBLIGATION (G.O.) BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- One City resident from the Mid-Beach Area.

7. HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (5):

- One member shall be an administrator from an adult congregate living facility (ACLF), and/or an assisted living facility (ALF). (Category # 3)

- One (1) member shall be a representative of the nursing profession. (Category # 4)
- One member shall be a health benefits provider. (Category # 5)
- One Ex-Officio, Miami-Dade County Health Department.
- One Ex-Officio, Health Council of South Florida.

8. HEALTH FACILITIES AUTHORITY BOARD

VACANCY (1):

- One individual in the field of general business who possesses good standing in the community.
- One Attorney.

9. HUMAN RIGHTS COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (3):

- Three members who shall reflect, as nearly as possible, the diversity of individuals protected under the City's Human Rights Ordinance.

10. NEXT GENERATION COUNCIL (1-year term)

VACANCIES (2):

Members must be between 18 and 40 years old at the time of appointment.

- One member must be a business owner in the City. (Category A)
- One member must be licensed and actively practicing in the field of architecture or engineering. (Category C)

11. NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT

VACANCY (1):

- A member of the Executive Committee of the Normandy Shores Homeowners Association.

12. NORTH BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- One member who is an attorney with experience in land use, real estate, or other related practice areas, residing generally within the City of Miami Beach or maintaining a full-time law practice and physical office located in North Beach. (Category # 4)

Each member must have demonstrated interest in neighborhood leadership issues, including, without limitation, neighborhood business groups, homeowner or condominium associations and cooperatives, civic groups, and/or other similar qualifications.

13. PERSONNEL BOARD (5/7 vote required)

VACANCY (1):

- One citizen of Miami Beach, not employed by the City and not having the same vocation as any other member of the Personnel Board. (Excluded vocations: Human Resources Director, International Sales Manager/Consultant, Clinical Pharmacist, Concert Producer/Impresario, and Assistant General Manager.)

14. SENIORS AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (5):

- One individual selected by the board of directors of Jewish Community Services of South Florida. (Category # 1)
- One resident of the Blackstone Apartments who shall be recommended by the residents of the Blackstone Apartments and ratified by the City Commission. (Category # 4)
- One resident of Stella Maris House selected by the board of directors of Stella Maris House. (Category # 5)
- One resident of Council Towers North who shall be recommended by the residents of Council Towers North and ratified by the City Commission. (Category # 7)
- One resident of Council Towers South who is recommended by the residents of Council Towers South and ratified by the city commission. (Category # 8)

15. TRANSPORTATION, PARKING, AND BICYCLE-PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- One South Beach neighborhood association member. (Category # 2)
