WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach is committed to being prudent and fiscally responsible; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires that the City Administration, including the City Manager and Department Directors, identify and implement cost-saving and efficiency measures within all departments to ensure the City's budget is managed effectively; and

WHEREAS, these measures could include, by way of example, evaluating underutilized subscriptions, software agreements, hardware, and other resources to identify cost-saving opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, in conjunction with the Police Department, should evaluate if there are jobs, roles, or responsibilities that non-sworn, civilian personnel can perform at a lower overall cost; and

WHEREAS, additional cost-saving measures may include optimizing energy usage, reducing overtime expenses, consolidating services, renegotiating vendor contracts, and implementing technology solutions to streamline operations; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that these cost-saving and efficiency measures do not negatively affect the level of service provided to residents and businesses in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration shall provide quarterly reports to the Mayor and City Commission on the progress of identifying and implementing these cost-saving and efficiency measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the City Administration to identify and implement within all department cost savings and efficiency measures that do not negatively affect the level of service provided to residents and businesses in the City.
