**WHEREAS**, the residents of Riviera Plaza Apartments, located at 337 20th St, Miami Beach, FL 33139 (the "Building") are facing an imminent move-out deadline by the end of August 2024, due to the Riviera Plaza Apartments being scheduled for renovations from a multi-family residence into a boutique hotel; and

**WHEREAS**, the owners filed an application before the City's Historic Preservation Board ("HPB") for a Certificate of Appropriateness for the partial demolition, renovation and restoration of the Building, including the introduction of a rooftop pool and decks on November 23, 2022 (HPB22-0554); and

**WHEREAS**, the HPB reviewed and approved the application on March 14, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequently, the applicant also submitted a request for a State Extension under the State of Emergency Declarations for Hurricane Ian and Hurricane Nicole in order to extend the Development Approval, which was granted and extended through July 9, 2029; and

**WHEREAS**, most of the residents of Riviera Plaza apartments are older adults and long-time residents of the building; and

**WHEREAS**, an extension of the move-out period would alleviate undue hardship on residents in finding suitable alternative housing, especially in view of the current housing shortage; and

**WHEREAS**, assistance with moving costs would lessen the financial burden on residents during this transition; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission respectfully urge the owners of the Riviera Plaza Apartments to extend the move-out period for current residents by no less than 30 days from the originally specified deadline, and to provide financial assistance to residents to help cover moving costs incurred as a result of the required relocation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby urge the owners of the Riviera Plaza Apartments to extend the move-out period for current residents by no less than 30 days from the originally specified deadline, and to provide financial assistance to residents to help cover moving costs incurred as a result of the required relocation; and further direct the City Clerk to transmit a copy of this Resolution to members of the City's Historic Preservation Board..
