RECOMMENDATION

Please place on the November 20, 2024 City Commission agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss potentially purchasing portable ticket printers to aid in the Police Department's issuance of UTCs.

The Miami Beach Police Department ("MBPD") is responsible for enforcing violations and issuing non-criminal traffic infractions within the City's jurisdictional territory. The presence of MBPD police officers actively patrolling neighborhoods and areas citywide allows officers to often observe violations and cite individuals with a non-criminal traffic infraction.

Portable ticket printers provide a convenient tool for those MBPD officers assigned to walk or bike through specific areas citywide to be able to quickly and safely enforce violations and issue non-criminal traffic infractions.

As part of this referral, I would request that the City Administration, including the Police Department, be prepared at Committee to discuss the utility and costs associated with purchasing portable ticket printers for the issuance of UTCs.
