ANALYSIS

Please place on the December 11, 2024 agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee ("PSNQLC") to discuss amending Section 82-58 of the City Code to allow for multifamily residence buildings to hold garage sales on no more than two (2) occasions during any 12-month period.

Currently, Section 86-58 of the City Code allows for a garage sale permit for any one single-family or multifamily residence building on no more than one occasion during any 12-month period. Allowing garage sales twice a year would give residents more opportunities to sell excess belongings and free up valuable space in their homes.
