### **RECOMMENDATION**

### **BACKGROUND/HISTORY**

Please place the above item on the December 11, 2024 City Commission meeting agenda as a referral to the Land Use and Sustainability Committee ("LUSC").

Currently, if the cost of renovations to a single-family home exceed 50% of the value of the existing building, the single-family home would lose its non-conformances and the entire property would be required to be brought up to the current Code. This includes existing landscaping requirements in the Land Development Regulations for new construction.

I would like the LUSC to consider whether the Land Development Regulations should be amended to provide relief from the City's landscaping requirements for renovations to single-family homes that exceed 50% of the value of the existing building. Any such relief shall, at a minimum, comply with any applicable minimum landscaping requirements in the Miami-Dade County Code, which apply to both unincorporated and incorporated areas of the County.
