RECOMMENDATION

I would like to refer to the Finance and Economic Resiliency Committee (FERC) a proposal to create a financial stipend of \$500 monthly for the aides of the Mayor and Commissioner's office. Due to high housing costs, a demanding schedule that requires in-person commitments during unpredictable hours, late nights, weekends, and, additionally, lack of wages in line with what would be workforce or attainable housing and a lack of meaningful supply for said housing supply from the City of Miami Beach.
